A word from the general director-

The 2020-2021 financial year went as planned under the triple mission of Consolidation, Growth and Development.

With the decisions taken by the Board of Directors in 2020-2021, the Jardins du Souvenir is taking responsibility and asserting itself. We are proud of our funeral home and our cemeteries, which are building an increasingly solid reputation for excellence throughout the Outaouais region.

Among the highlights of the past year, we underline:

- The completion of the construction work of the Calvary and the Stations of the Cross at the Notre-Dame cemetery;
- We continued to hold commemorative ceremonies in each of our cemeteries. At each event, we rediscover how important these events are for our customers and parishioners;
- The implementation of the provincial register of prearrangements and prearranged burials forced us to integrate these new requirements and new rates into our services. We worked along with the Archdiocese to inform representatives of parish cemeteries about the ins and outs of this new register;
- The decision to build the first phase of the Complexe funéraire Notre-Dame, which will be built onto the new garage (which we desperately need). Thanks to this project, we will be able to host more funerals and introduce more people to the advantage of offering all services under one roof;
- The multifaceted partnership that we have established with the Centre des services scolaires au Cœur des Vallées:
 - Certification program for our field operations employees;
 - ✓ Landscaping training program that will allow roughly ten of our employees to obtain a vocational studies diploma (DEP) while being paid throughout the winter;
 - ✓ The greenhouse project that we are going to offer to the École d'horticulture de Papineauville will give us access to the resource of students who will care for our plants and flowers over the next few years;
- Along with the union executive of the Jardins du Souvenir, we have undertaken to work in partnership to define the working conditions of employees;
- Seasonal employees now have "equal pay for equal work" in comparison to their regularly paid colleagues;
- We donated a terrace to Maison Mathieu Froment Savoie to improve the quality of life of residents and their families:
- We entered into a similar agreement with the Monarque residence in Plaisance;

- We have provided various construction or landscaping services to a few parish cemeteries for the upgrading of their facilities (St-Martin, Saint-Sixte);
- We welcomed the cemetery of Saint-Pierre de Wakefield into the big Jardins du Souvenir family;
- Throughout all of this, we continued to manage the COVID-19 crisis (reorganization of services, temporary layoffs, multiple rearrangements of premises and our facilities to ensure the safety of our employees and our customers).

I sincerely believe that we can all be proud of the work accomplished by the Board of Directors and the various Jardins du Souvenir teams. The results achieved are the fruits of serious commitment and hard work

The challenges that we face are only catalysts to our development, pushing us to transform them into opportunities.

Thank you to the members of the Board of Directors for their unwavering support. Without them, none of the above would have been possible. Thank you to God for granting me the privilege of serving Him. It is an honour and a renewed joy every day.

Structure and administration

Nomination and Mandate

The Board of Directors, which is entrusted with overall management, is an autonomous and indivisible entity. The archbishop appoints the seven (7) members on the proposal of the president. They are all residents of the territory of the Archdiocese of Gatineau and they come from different areas. The Archbishop hopes that efforts will be continued to achieve gender parity within the Council. In addition, members maintain direct and significant ties with the archdiocese and its parishes to ensure that the needs and realities experienced by them are well reflected around the table of the Board of Directors.

Structure

Les Jardins du Souvenir, as an archiepiscopal corporation with a single member, namely the Archbishop of the Diocese, has a simple organizational structure.

Vision, mission, objective

- 1. Ensure the sound management of Catholic cemeteries in the Outaouais region by maintaining these burial sites that are conducive to contemplation in order to ensure their sustainability with concession holders.
- 2. Offer complete and personalized funeral services in accordance with family, religious, cultural and personal traditions in order to meet the last wishes of the deceased.

SECTORS OF ACTIVITY:

Funeral and cemetery

Funerals

- We offer all funeral services under one roof: transport of the deceased, asepsis, identification, embalming, production of legal documents for the various levels of government, publication of obituaries, organization of funerals, funeral ceremonies, reception hall, etc.
- Funeral ceremonies can also be held outside (at the lot, under a tent, under the trees in the Jardin des cendres (Ash Garden)).

Cemeteries

- We offer the rental of concessions (lots), indoor and outdoor columbaria as well as burial places in our various mausoleums.
- Interment (burial) for urns and coffins in all our cemeteries (available in winter in certain cemeteries).
- Installation of tents and chairs for burials.
- We now offer ecological sections in some of our cemeteries.
- Sale of urn products and biodegradable coffins.
- Sale of monuments, columbaria, plaques and other granite products.
- Construction of foundations, cleaning of monuments and sale of annual flowers.
- Receiving vault rental for the winter period.
- · Angels section for children who left us too soon.
- Stations of the Cross and Calvary for contemplation and meditation.
