



A word from the director general

The 2021–2022 financial year could be seen as the year of affirmation.

The year of affirmation that our "cemetery customers" are customers in their own right and that they deserve professional and quality services. The year in which we put an end to the tightening grip of funeral homes on our cemetery services and where we regained control of our operations.

The year of affirmation that the residents of Petite Nation deserve that we set up in their region and serve them in their community.

The year of the affirmation that our employees are our most important asset and that by working together, we manage to achieve the impossible.

With the decisions taken by the Management Committee and the Board of Directors in 2021–2022, the Jardins du Souvenir is firmly committed to the path of growth and development. We are proud of our funeral home and our cemeteries, which are building an increasingly solid reputation for excellence throughout the Outaouais region.

Among the highlights of the past year, we underline:

- We welcomed the Saint-Émile-de-Suffolk parish cemetery into the big Jardins du Souvenir family;
- We completed the digitization of our 25,000 cemetery files, which now allow our consultants to have access to their customers' files wherever they are:
- We have converted the old receiving vault in the Saint-Rédempteur cemetery into a reception area and a chapel. Thanks to this project, we can start serving our customers directly on site at the cemetery again and put an end to a more than 50-year hiatus (dating back to the year of the Guardian House demolition);
- We integrated the files of the Saint-Antoine de Padoue parish cemetery and took care of its upkeep pending the official transfer of the parish cemetery to the Jardins du Souvenir;
- We opened a service point in Saint-André-Avellin where two consultants offer our full range of funeral and cemetery services to the population of Petite Nation (pre-arrangement, funerals, sales of concessions, monuments, etc.);
- Our Petite Nation consultants took part in the training of parish cemetery managers in order to help them integrate their cemetery data into management software. This service was offered free of charge to the Petite Nation parishes;
- We continued to hold commemorative ceremonies in each of our cemeteries. At each event, we rediscovered how important these events are for our customers and parishioners;
- As in past years, we contributed significantly to the success of the Archbishop's Golf Open, which raises funds to support community organizations;
- We continued to help the parish cemeteries that call on us for their digging, burial and repair needs;

- We offered training on the "sustainable development of cemeteries" to many parish cemetery managers as well as to all our employees;
- We worked on a new version of our Notre-Dame Funeral Complex construction project;
- We continued to expand the number of funeral customers we served during the year;
- We were awarded the "Certification Distinction" for the excellence of our funeral services at the Corporation des thanatologues du Québec convention last September in Saint-Hyacinthe;
- We continued the multifaceted partnership that we established with the Centre des services scolaires au Cœur des Vallées during this year, which led to the graduation (DEP) of certain employees and the obtaining of a certificate of studies for several others;
- We continued our investments to equip our field operations team with modern machinery and equipment to help them deal with environmental challenges and the increase in the number of our cemeteries.

I sincerely believe that we can all be proud of the work accomplished by the Management Committee, the Board of Directors and the various *Jardins du Souvenir* teams. The results achieved are the fruits of serious commitment and hard work.

We still have a lot to do to ensure the financial sustainability of the organization. We have the necessary ingredients to achieve our ultimate goal: to be the best in our field.

Thank you to the Board members for their unwavering support. Thank you to my colleagues on the Management Committee for their outstanding commitment to *Les Jardins du Souvenir*. Without them, none of the above would have been possible. Thank you to God for granting me the privilege of serving Him. It is an honour and a renewed joy every day.

Structure and administration


Structure

Les Jardins du Souvenir, as an archiepiscopal corporation with a single member, namely the Archbishop of the Diocese, has a simple organizational structure.

— Nomination and mandate

The Board of Directors, which is entrusted with overall management, is an autonomous and indivisible entity.

The archbishop appoints the seven (7) members according to the president's proposal. They are all residents of the territory of the Archdiocese of Gatineau and they come from different sectors. The Archbishop hopes that efforts will be continued to achieve gender parity within the Board. In addition, members maintain direct and significant ties with the archdiocese and its parishes to ensure that the needs and realities experienced by them are well reflected around the table of the Board of Directors.



Vision, mission, objective

Les Jardins du Souvenir, Maison funéraire et cimetières, has a double mission:

- 1. Ensure the sound management of Catholic cemeteries in the Outaouais region by maintaining these burial sites that are conducive to contemplation in order to ensure their sustainability with concession holders.
- 2. Offer complete and personalized funeral services in accordance with family, religious, cultural, and personal traditions in order to meet the last wishes of the deceased.

Our Objective

Les Jardins du Souvenir, Maison funéraire et cimetières has as its main objective to meet the needs of individuals and families while respecting their traditions and their last wishes, at a competitive price.

SECTORS OF ACTIVITY:

Funerals and cemeteries.

Funerals

- Funeral pre-arrangement;
- Cremation:
- We offer all funeral services under one roof: transport of the deceased, asepsis, identification, embalming, production of legal documents for the various levels of government, publication of obituaries, organization of funerals, funeral ceremonies, reception hall, webcasting of funerals, etc.
- Funeral ceremonies can also be held outside (at the lot, under a tent, under the trees in the Jardin des cendres (Ash Garden));
- Reception hall (and outdoor tents in summer) for gatherings and receptions after the funeral.

Cemeteries

- We offer the rental of concessions (lots), indoor and outdoor columbaria as well as burial places in our various mausoleums;
- Interment (burial) for urns and coffins in all our cemeteries (available in winter in certain cemeteries);
- Installation of tents and chairs for burials;
- We now offer ecological sections in some of our cemeteries;
- Sale of urn products and biodegradable coffins;
- Sale of monuments, columbaria, plaques and other granite products;
- Construction of foundations, cleaning of monuments and sale of annual flowers;
- Receiving vault rental for the winter period;
- Angels section for children who left us too soon;
- Stations of the Cross and Calvary for contemplation and meditation.

^{*}We manage the files and the maintenance of the St. James cemetery, in addition to offering maintenance services to the St. Stephen cemetery in Chelsea and the West-Templeton cemetery.

Highlights and achievements:

- Inauguration in July 2022 of our satellite office in Saint-André-Avellin to serve the population of Petite Nation. Two consultants work on site to offer our various products and services as well as to support parish cemeteries;
- Opening in June 2022 of a reception and information area at the Saint-Rédempteur cemetery. The reception hall, which can accommodate around 30 people, is also used for funeral celebrations and receptions after burials:
- Steady increase in the number of deaths treated in our facilities;
- Obtaining of diplomas and certifications by some of the members of our field operations team thanks to a partnership with the Centre des Services scolaires au Cœur des vallées for the training of our staff in landscaping and gardening;

- Human resources in constant growth as well as improvement of attraction and retention of personnel;
- Modernization of our facilities and equipment;
- On-site cremation service;
- Extension of our burial schedule (8 a.m. to 8 p.m.) in the summer season;
- Geolocation service for concessions (lots) in our cemeteries;
- Completion of the digitization of all our cemetery files;
- We adapt our ceremonies to meet the particular needs of communities and families;
- Member of the Board of Directors of the l'Association des Cimetières Chrétiens du Québec (ACCQ);
- Members of the Corporation des thanatologues du Québec.
